Degree Information. You must complete 144 credit points to finish your degree with the course structure as listed above. Each semester subject is six credit points. Full time equivalent (FTE) is 24 credit points per semester however Centrelink consider 18 credit points as FTE also.

Tabor Core. These are subjects that need to be completed by the end of your degree. You can do them at any time. Some are also available over summer school or online. Note that Ethics has a prerequisite of Meaningful Living.

Co-curricula*. All students enrolled in the BMus need to choose at least one co-curricula music ensemble to be a part of (subject to change depending on lecturer availability). You can change ensembles each semester. The co-curricular (small) ensemble must be different to your music performance (large) ensemble.

- 1. Choose your music performance (large) ensemble: Funk Band, Gospel Choir, Orchestra or a Capella (auditioned only).
- 2. Choose a different large or small ensemble for your co-curricular.

Large (Music Performance) Ensembles: any of the above as well as Rock Band and Worship Band

*if there are too many musicians per ensemble, auditions will be made.

Elective . You must complete 24 credit points of electives:

- In another discipline area which enables a minor (ie. Creative Writing, Maths)
- Electives can be music or across the College
- Electives can be all music as listed above in yellow

Ensure that you check any restrictions and prerequisites
